



MVA Enrollment Guidelines

To be considered for enrollment students must:

- Fellowship at Modoc Vineyard Church, another Bible-believing church or have at least one custodial parent who has accepted Jesus Christ as their personal savior and is actively practicing their faith;
- Maintain a doctrinal position which supports the Modoc Vineyard Church *Statement of Faith*;
- Have a satisfactory citizenship record in the school they are presently attending;
- Desire to attend Modoc Vineyard Academy and be willing to comply with the school's standards as stated in the student handbook.

Students and siblings that are currently attending Modoc Vineyard Church or have family on the MVA Board will have priority enrollment.

Modoc Vineyard Academy operates as a ministry of Modoc Vineyard Church. For more information on our *Statement of Faith* and basic discipleship practices visit www.modocvineyard.church. At least one custodial parent/guardian of each student must sign the application acknowledging agreement with the MVA policies and procedures as stated in the MVA Student Handbook and guiding documents.

Follow these steps to begin the Student Enrollment Process:

1. Complete the attached *Student Application* for each student you are enrolling. In order to streamline the process, we ask that your application be filled out in its entirety prior to submission.
2. Submit your application to the Modoc Vineyard Academy as soon as possible to reserve a space for your child. Along with your completed application, you will be required to pay the **non-refundable registration fee of \$250.00 per student**. Fees must be submitted by check or money order. The registration fee covers the enrollment process and classroom supplies.
3. Tuition of **\$250 monthly** will be due by the fifth of the month every month for 10 months (Aug-May)

MVA Late Enrollment Guidelines:

The students who are considered for late enrollment are students that would begin school after the first day classes are in session, which is the Tuesday after Labor Day weekend.

Students must:

- Fellowship at Modoc Vineyard Church, another bible-believing church or have at least one custodial parent who has accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior that is actively practicing their faith.
- Those whose doctrinal position supports the Modoc Vineyard Church *Statement of Faith*.
- Have a satisfactory citizenship record in the school they are presently attending.
- Desire to attend Modoc Vineyard Academy and be willing to comply with the school's standards as stated in the student handbook.

Students and siblings that are currently attending Modoc Vineyard Church or have family on the MVA board will have priority enrollment.

Modoc Vineyard Academy will operate as a ministry of Modoc Vineyard Church. For more information on our statement of faith and basic discipleship practices visit www.modocvineyard.church.

Follow these steps to begin the student enrollment process:

1. Complete the attached *Student Application* for each student you are enrolling. To streamline the process, we ask that your application be filled out in its entirety prior to submission.
2. Submit your application to the Modoc Vineyard Academy as soon as possible for review. We will do our best to accommodate late enrollment but cannot guarantee admission. If we do not have the space or resources available, your student will be put on our wait list.
3. Along with your completed application, to reserve your student's spot you will be required to pay the **non-refundable late registration fee of \$300.00 per student**. Fees must be submitted by check or money order. Registration fee covers the enrollment process, assessments, and necessary classroom supplies.
4. Once your student is accepted and enrolled there will be an additional fee of **\$250 for curriculum**. This fee is non-refundable, curriculum becomes the property of the student. MVA uses Abeka curriculum. The lessons for the entire year arrive fully prepared and students work directly out of their workbooks.
5. Monthly tuition will begin the month of our start date once your student is accepted and will be **\$250 per month through the month of May**. If your students start admitted after the first week of the month MVA will prorate that fee by deducting \$62.50 per week according to start date.

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
